## Things you may want to know this week

This Sunday we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** On November 1, 1950, Pius XII defined the dogma of the Assumption and solemnly proclaimed that at the end of her earthly life, the Blessed Virgin Mary was taken up, body and soul, into the glory of heaven. The solemnity supersedes the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary which could have been celebrated if August 15 did not fall on a Sunday.

We had a funeral today for ROY BLANCO, an active parishioner and choir member of our parish, who peacefully passed away August 7th at the age of 75.
