Things you may want to know this week

1. It's our monthly **School Family Mass** this Sunday at the 9:30AM mass sponsored by our **6th graders**. We will also be bringing back our Altar Server' starting this Sunday. Although their function will still be limited to carrying the cross and ringing the bells, their presence certainly adds color and creates an impact in the liturgy.
