Things you may want to know this week

1. The **Fall Season** officially started last Wednesday, September 22. As we celebrate the first weekend of Fall, let us join our **St. Robert's Fil-Am ministry** as they "fall on their knees" to honor **San Lorenzo Ruiz**, the First Filipino saint. The statue of the saint will be put on display in front of the church this weekend.
2. The **Ministry Leaders** of our parish will be having a General Meeting this Tuesday, September 28, 2021 at 7PM at the church. If you feel you are called to participate in the life of the church, you are more than welcome to attend this meeting. The evening's discussion will focus on discovering our gifts and how we can move forward in the years ahead.
3. We will have an **Animal Blessing** this year! It will be on Saturday, October 2, 2021, at 9:15AM at the school yard. We were not able to do this last year because of Covid. Traditionally, we have this annually on the first Saturday of October, closest to October 4, the feast of St. Francis, patron of animals and ecology. This year we have moved it to an earlier time.

To augment their offertory giving and Archdiocesan Annual Appeal, the churches of San Bruno and St. Thomas Moore have organized two separate **concerts** featuring **Shane Ericks**, a youtube sensation who sings like Karen Carpenter.
