## Things you may want to know this week

1. This weekend is the launching of our **2023 Archdiocesan Annual Appeal (AAA)**. The theme of our AAA this year is: *"Your Word is a Lamp for my Feet, a Light for my Path."* Our parish assessment this year or the goal set for us by the Archdiocese is \$103,208, higher than last year's \$92,145. I hope and pray that we can replicate the success of last year's appeal where we exceeded the goal, and the surplus allotted for our Grotto project. With your support, yes, we can!
2. Great things are happening this Sunday. At the 9:30 a.m. Mass, we will have **the Rite of Sending** for our RCIA candidates, those who will receive the Sacraments of Initiation on Easter Vigil. Later in the afternoon, they will go to St. Mary's Cathedral for the Rite of Election presided by our Archbishop Cordileone. Our Confirmation candidates from our parish Religious Education Program will also be having a Retreat in the afternoon which will conclude with the 5 p.m. Mass.
3. The annual **Religious Education Congress** (LAREC), sponsored by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles Office of Religious Education, is one of the nation's largest annual gatherings of Roman Catholics! It started with Youth Day, yesterday, and will end this Sunday. With 40,000 in attendance over the four days, the Congress offers nearly 200 speakers presenting 300 sessions, e.g., personal growth and other spiritual topics. The event will also showcase hundreds of exhibitors – such as religious art, music, publishing houses and educational institutions. We sent a few delegates: **Vice Principal Edgar Ceja**, representing the school, **Cecile Sabater**, representing our parish and **Jayden Sabater**, representing our youth. When they get back they will have a lot of experiences and knowledge to share with us.
4. **Bishop Ignatius Wang**, auxiliary bishop emeritus of San Francisco is turning 90 this coming Monday. He will be celebrating his birthday with a concelebrated Mass at St. Anne of the Sunset, tomorrow, February 25, at 11:00 a.m. Bishop Wang was in residence at Holy Name for more than 20 years, and we spent 11 years together when I was pastor there. Happy Birthday Bishop Wang!
5. A **new gas meter** was installed in our rectory to accommodate the new church heating system load. With the new gas meter, the heating system will have better efficiency thereby avoiding possible overload.
6. Let's grow deeper in our spirituality by participating in our spiritual exercises this Lent.
  - a. Join us for **Stations of the Cross** every Friday at 6:00 p.m. Tonight, it will be led by our Saint Vincent de Paul Society.
  - b. On March 13-14, we will have a **Parish Mission**, a kind of mini-Retreat, from 7:00-8:30 a.m. **Fr. Bong Guerrero**, a charismatic priest from the Philippines, is going to lead us in a reflection on the accountability of serving. Please invite your friends!
  - c. Beautiful hand-made olive wood **religious articles** made by Catholic families in Bethlehem and Jerusalem will be on sale on the first weekend of March (3/4-3/5), after all the Masses. Bethlehem Artworks is an organization that provides assistance to over 100 plus suffering families each week.
