God with Us

There is a wonderful piece of the Acts reading which was left out of the passage we hear today. Previously, Peter and John had been arrested and warned not to preach about Jesus, so when they are arrested a second time, members of the Sanhedrin want to kill them. Gamaliel, a Pharisee, wisely counsels them: "If this enterprise, this movement of theirs, is of human origin it will break up of its own accord; but if it does in fact come from God, you will not only be unable to destroy them, but you might find yourselves fighting against God." (Acts 5. 39) So, fortunately for us, Peter and John are set free and we are blest with the Spirit-led power of their preaching passed on through their communities in the scripture.

Throughout this 50-day Easter season, the second reading is from the Book of Revelation, the most misunderstood book of the Bible. John is writing to encourage Christians undergoing terrible persecution not to lose hope. He'll use strong poetic imagery: "the triumphant Lamb of God (this Sunday); the vast multitude who survived "the great distress" (fourth Sunday); the passing away of the old world and the arrival of a "new Jerusalem" (fifth and sixth Sundays) and the promise of the One called "the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last," who is "coming soon" (seventh Sunday)." (Jude Siciliano, OP, First Impressions, Apr. 16)

Perhaps, we will hear John's words differently with hearts saddened by the reports of clergy abuse and hierarchical cover-up. Our Risen Lord continues to be with us in the present and the future, with the Spirit continuing to guide us. We might ask in prayer today: what is our role in making the Church look more like the kingdom Jesus had in mind? Even in the midst of our disappointment, may the peace of the Risen Lord be with us. **Sister Sheral**
