Dear Parishioners,

The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ always reminds me of my Grandmother. When I spent weekends with my Grandmother, I expected to get up early Sunday and walk a mile to church, regardless of the weather. On the Friday evening of my solo bus trip, we also walked to church for Forty Hours, which began with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and ended with the Corpus Christi procession after the last Mass Sunday. Usually going to church with Grandmother was fine, but that night I had to ask Grandmother how long we were going to be there. "Do you have something better to do?" she asked with a smile. I didn't understand her words, but remembered them. Later as a student of Liturgical spirituality, I learned that "seeing the Lord" has a long history in Christian tradition.

At the beginning of Sunday's Gospel, Jesus urges his disciples to give the crowd something to eat themselves. This is our call, too, to hand on what we become in the Eucharist—nourishment is abundance for all. Eucharist is a communal liturgical action, in which we experience communion as the body of Christ. Our celebration expresses hope that all may be one and spurs us action for transforming the world.

Some parishes today promote adoration of the Blessed Sacrament 24/7. Interest in this devotion may express a felt need for deeper communion between "me and Jesus." Or, it may respond to a need for more than public celebration of piety. Perhaps this devotion expresses a hunger for communion with One who gazes upon us. Or, perhaps gazing upon the bread of life and cup of salvation is a way to seek a future to hope in. Private devotion to the Blessed Sacrament ought to strengthen our public communal participation in Eucharist Liturgy. As my Grandmother understood, we gaze to know we are being gazed upon and called to live as the Body of Christ in our world.

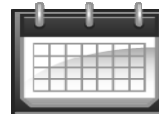

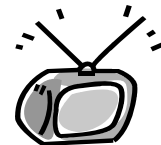

LIVING THE LITURGY

The Body and Blood of the Lord

The readings this weekend are terrific! We know the I Corinthians reading almost by heart, since it is the institution narrative we hear at every Eucharist. We know the gospel, too, since it is the much-loved story of the loaves and fishes. Still, this feast can wake us up on many levels. It is a reminder that Jesus really did take on our flesh and blood, shared our joys and our sorrows. He was God's love brought close to us and made flesh for everyone who saw him, heard him or knew him as neighbor, teacher and friend of God, at least. We are to be the same – God's love made manifest to our family members, acquaintances, co-workers, strangers. He has no hands but ours, one of the saints said, and it's true. Do people see Jesus when they see us? It's quite an invitation!

The other invitation in this feast is the reality of food; he becomes our food that we may be nourished by his very being. But what about everyone who is starving? Missionaries in times past wisely fed the hungry people they came to preach to, for how can anyone listen with an empty stomach? Nowadays, they often come with technical skills and agricultural know how, so they can help the people increase their yield of crops. www.bread.org is the website for Bread for the World, a Christian group which tries to make more food available through legislation to feed those who are hungry here at home with a fully-funded WIC program, for example, and abroad through increasing our development aid to desperately poor countries. Even though it isn't Lent, what if as we enjoy summer fun, those of us who can, gave our signatures or our "bread" to a group like this?
