Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday at the 5pm Mass we will be celebrating the first of three scrutinies for our RCIA elect and candidates. Pearl Ho and Eduardo Madera are our two elect, those adults preparing for Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.

We have 5 candidates this year. Twila Morales, who was baptized in another faith, will be making a Profession of Faith and receiving Confirmation and Eucharist. Leonora Madera will be receiving her First Communion and Confirmation. Raquel Gonzalez, Miguel Nava and Mark Tobin will be receiving Confirmation on Pentecost Sunday at St. Mary's Cathedral.

Scrutinies are rites celebrated in order to deliver the elect and candidates from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation and to give them strength in Christ. The elect participate in these rites for self-searching and repentance to uncover all that is weak, defective, or sinful in their hearts. After identifying what is weak, they can then also bring out and strengthen all that is upright, strong and good.

During the first 300 years of our faith, lent was the last 40 days of 3 years for adults in preparation for becoming part of our faith. After three years you can imagine how excited they were on Easter Sunday after being welcomed into the church. Eventually, the whole community wanted to remember the joy of their own Baptism, so more and more of the community would participate in Lent in preparation for Easter.

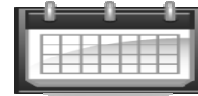

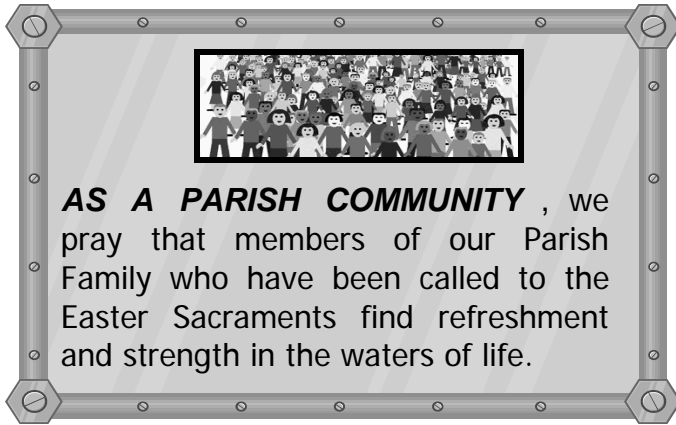
