OUR NEW PASTOR

We welcome our new pastor, Father John L. Greene, on Monday July 2nd. Fr. Greene was ordained 36 years ago on May 15, 1976. He grew up in Vallejo, California and attended public schools there. He graduated from St. Patrick's College in 1972 and received his Masters Degree from St. Patrick's Seminary in 1976. He has served as an Assistant Pastor at Star of the Sea, San Francisco, St. Mary's in Los Gatos, St. Paul's Epiphany, St. Michael's and St. Stephens, all in San Francisco and for the last thirteen years as the Pastor of St. Monica's in San Francisco. In addition, Fr. Greene was the administrator of Our Lady of Fatima Russian Byzantine Catholic Parish.

Fr. Greene has also been the Catholic Chaplain of the San Francisco Fire Dept. for 30 years, succeeding Msgr. Bruce Dreier who first invited Fr. Greene to assist him as a Fire Department chaplain. He will continue this ministry while serving as our Pastor and he hopes over the next year to know more about the parish and to have the opportunity to meet many of you.
