Dear Parishioners,

While every Sunday Eucharist is, by the nature of the liturgy, itself, a celebration of divine mercy, the Sunday at the end of Easter Week is observed as Divine Mercy Sunday (drawing to completion a novena begun on Good Friday). We specifically acknowledge divine mercy as the source of God's saving will and actions, and seek to promote that same power in the world. How fitting this is, living in a world where human vision and ambition have pushed conditions to such a dire state where only divine mercy can save us.

Praying for mercy... What image does that conjure in your mind? Hearing that, most of us would picture someone on their knees asking for God to ease up on whatever is pressuring them, be it a judge, an external threat to their well being, or even something interior, like anxiety, bringing them suffering.

There tends to be a directional character to our perception of mercy, and it usually involves God or somebody else showing mercy to us. We dedicate this week, with special vigor, to bringing mercy to bear in our own lives, by making a conscious effort to direct our prayers for God's mercy toward the whole world, and particularly toward those who have wronged us. And that God will help us become more merciful toward others.

As with every gift from God, we find ourselves receiving more mercy from God when we share it more generously with others. And our words and acts of mercy, given humbly, serve as a bright beacon to others. It is the light of Christ that drives away darkness and despair.

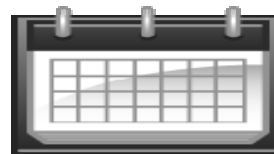
Let the prayer for Divine Mercy be the prayer of our hearts this week, and throughout our lives. *May Almighty God have mercy on us, and on the whole world.*
