Dear Parishioners,

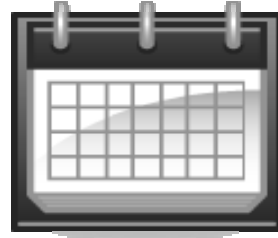
The readings for this weekend are interesting. The Acts of the Apostles, composed by Luke's community, continues to tell of Paul's exploits and how he preaches the word to Gentiles – non-Jews - in many communities. But the passage from the Book of Revelation was what has caught my eye and my heart. Reading this passage after the Boston Marathon bombings and so much other violence, it sounds both comforting and challenging.

“Behold, God’s dwelling is with the human race. He will dwell with them and they will be his people and God himself will always be with them as their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there shall be no more death or mourning, wailing or pain, for the old order has passed away.”

It might help us to recall that this book was composed when the community, known as followers of the Way, was being persecuted. And yet...They and we are being asked to believe when believing is difficult. They didn't experience the Sequester, home foreclosures or gun violence. But their very lives were in danger and still they believed. Can we believe in God's dream for our world? Can we see signs of God's kingdom in peaceable multi-generational, multi-ethnic neighborhoods and working groups? Can we see God's grace active in the daily, loving care of family members for special needs children and elders who require assistance with the smallest tasks? Can we perceive God's ingenuity, evident in science and technology enabling the rural doctor with the rare medical case to access her Johns Hopkins colleague who discovered the protocol for it? “Behold, I make all things new” the reading concludes. Do we have eyes to see?

Saint Robert Catholic School invites you to become a permanent part of the beauty of our campus by purchasing a limited commemorative brick for the new BEAR WALK.

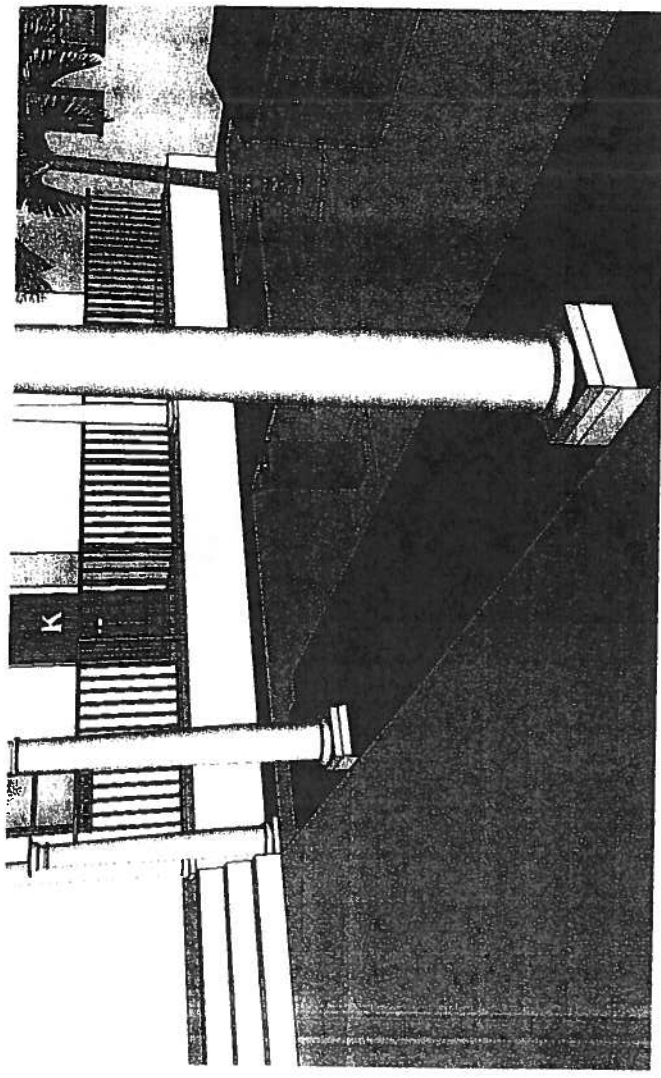
The walkway will be installed along the path from Oak Street up to the Kindergarten classroom. We hope to have the new path in place during summer 2013.

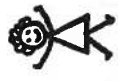
