Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate The Presentation of the Lord. I sit here looking out at Gene's garden and picture Mary (a 15 year old girl) who is now a mother...a very special mother – The Mother of God. Experiencing the miracle of birth is awe-inspiring to any woman. What must it have been for Mary when she realizes that she is God's Mother? Joseph leads her to the temple, astride their donkey, snuggling her precious Jesus close to her heart.

Into the temple they walk – a teenage girl, with her new born baby in her arms; her strong, protective husband by her side. They come upon Simeon, a wise man, and Anna, a very old widow. Both have been waiting all their lives to see the Messiah –the Son of God. They recognize Jesus immediately and thank God for the gift of beholding His Light of the World.

All ages are represented at this holy Presentation. Jesus came to save each of us -- from infant to those who are of advanced years and all who are in between. Each life is sacred. Simeon tells Mary, ***"You yourself a sword will pierce – so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed."*** This sword of grief that Mary experienced at the crucifixion and death of her Son has opened her heart to every mother. Each is welcome with open arms to come to Mary; pour out her heart, asking her help for her children and for herself.

Our Father gave us Jesus. He also gave us Mary to be our Mother. Her heart is big enough to hold us all. Let us go to Mary in our need. She will hear us and bring us to Jesus.

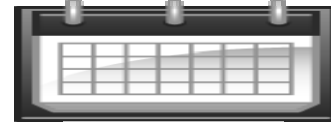
