Dear Parishioners,

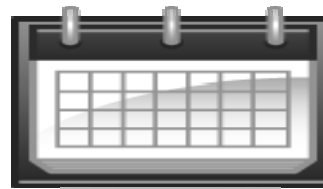
Inevitably, in our lives we stand at the graves of those we love. Perhaps it is misting as it was when I stood at my brother's grave, shoveling dirt into his place of rest. It was early January this year- this final family act of love seemed like planting for the Fall, and yet uncertain for the spring. When we bury those we love, we lose all they learned in their lives. The way they lived their lives, their wisdom, their relationship, with others the way the holy showed through in their kindness and what lives on. Every death raises questions about its meaning and makes of our graves places where faith must begin. Our graves ask the question: What do I believe about God? Sometimes when the veil between worlds seem thin, we experience our loved ones intensely present with us. None of us knows what lies beyond death. We have only our experience of God in our world and in our holy history. Christians are companions in hope that the God who creates and sustains the world will raise us up. We are companions in hope that the new life Jesus promises will be our own. Jesus' delay in the gospel story provides the reason for His dialog with Martha, who speaks the faith of the community that experienced this delay in history. Her brother's death tests and transforms Martha's faith. Jesus hears every prayer you make, even if He doesn't answer you right away He is with you even when He is holding back His healing touch. He may not give you what you ask for, but perhaps He will give you an increased compassion for other people's suffering, and the best of all, He will give you the greatest of all gifts - an ever deepening relationship with Him.

**Holy Communion to the Homebound**

You have probably noticed that during Mass the celebrant is inviting those bringing Communion to the homebound or hospitals to come up after we've all received Communion. If you have a family member or neighbor who cannot come to Mass, you can either call Sr. Patricia at 589-0104 and ask her to have one of the Eucharistic Ministers bring Communion or you can bring the person Holy Communion yourself. You just need to have a small container, called a pyx, into which the host can be placed. Please see Sr. Sheral or one of the priests before Mass begins.
