achieving the end for which I sent it."*

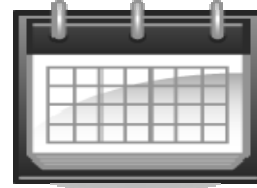
This prophecy in Isaiah 55:10-11 is fulfilled in Christ the Living Word, who emptied himself of his divinity to share in our humanity, all the way to the point of sharing even our earthly death. Jesus brought many to faith by his words and deeds, gathered them back to God through a baptism of repentance, and reconciled sinners to God by his dying and rising. This has come to be known as the Wondrous Exchange, in which the Sinless One trades places with sinners, taking their place in death so that they might take his place in eternal life.

Jesus alluded to this work not finishing with his rising from the dead, as He referred also to his "returning to the Father" in connection with his passion predictions. And in his Ascension to the Father the journey of the Son came full circle, taking the position of highest honor, trust, and authority in God's Kingdom, serving also as advocate and intercessor for his followers.

In his Ascension, God's Word (Christ) does not return empty, but produces a great harvest of souls, bringing many to redemption by faith. Let us open our hearts more to God's Word, that we might be sanctified and redeemed by it, for God's glory and our salvation. And that we might show forth in our lives the grace of God that unites us for ever with Him in the mystery of his mercy and love.


