May God bless our parish festival and all those who work on it and attend it.

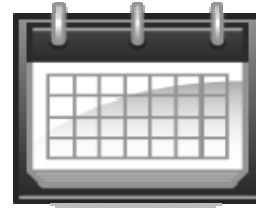

About Holy Communion

The Office of Worship has asked that Extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist who are not ordained not make the sign of the cross on the foreheads of those children or adults who do not receive Holy Communion. This is due to hygiene concerns and also to acknowledge that ordained ministers, that is, priests and deacons, are the only ones to bless someone with the sign of the cross. The lay Eucharistic ministers will place their hand on the shoulder of the child or adult and simply say, "God bless you."

Also, please recall that the respectful way to receive the Body of Christ is to place your right hand under your left ("making an altar for the host", as the children are taught), then picking up the Host in your right hand to receive. If you don't wish to drink the Precious Blood, you don't have to; you have received the Lord in the host alone. Please do not dip the host in the Precious Blood. Thank you.

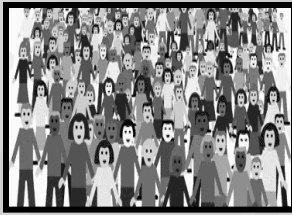
