What a marvelous set of readings the Church gives us this Sunday! The Isaiah reading emphasizes God's almost unbelievable mercy, a reality Pope Francis wants us to keep before our eyes. Paul reminds us that, as enjoyable as this life is for many of us, we are destined for heaven and union with Christ. This gospel always puzzled my Dad, a very fair man, from whom I inherited my own passion for justice. Being a businessman, he couldn't imagine two workers putting in such different hours of labor being paid the same wage. And, of course, that's the point: God's generosity to us is way beyond what we can ever ask or imagine. But, since we are made in God's image, couldn't we at least **try** to be like God in our own everyday generosity towards members of our families, our communities, our workplaces?

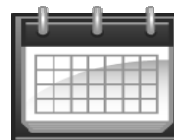
I want to let you know that I won't be here the majority of October. I've been elected a delegate to the every five year international Chapter of my Franciscan congregation. I'll be with the provincials (regional leadership sisters) and two delegates from our 10 provinces as we meet in Rome to discuss how we are living the Gospel today which Francis and Clare so powerfully lived in their times. Though English is the congregational language, there will be lots of translation going on for our Brazilian, Tanzanian, Polish and Indonesian Sisters. We will also be electing our international leaders for the next five years. We'll begin in Assisi on October 3, the day St. Francis died in 1226, and then go to Rome for the rest of our time together. I'd be grateful for your prayers.
