Fr. Mike, our associate pastor will be on extended sick leave.

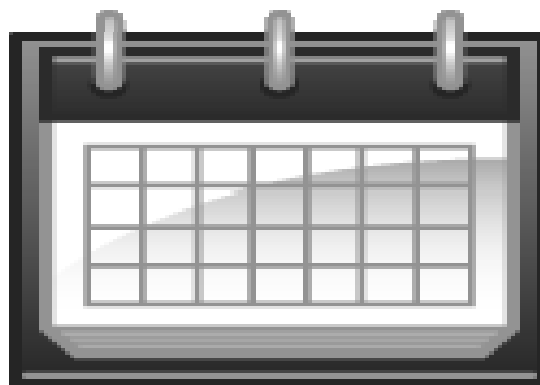
6:30 AM Masses
