Today we celebrate the Feast of St. Anne and St. Joachim, parents of Mary. Sitting here on our deck overlooking Gene's garden, sipping Vanilla Chai tea, my thoughts wander back to this day many long years ago.

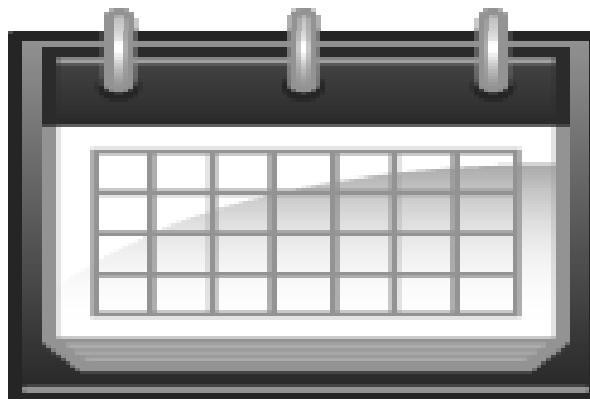
Every July, our Mom would bring us to St. Anne's Church in the Sunset for the St. Anne's novena. One day, we asked her "Why?" Mom explained: Due to an illness, her sister Mary Grace's right leg failed to grow. It was 4 inches shorter than her left. Day-in and day-out, Little Grace sadly sat on the steps of their home on 24th Street watching the other children play. Our Mom, Anne Imelda, who at that time was six years old – two years younger than Grace – encouragingly sat beside her.

On this day, 102 years ago, Mom and her sisters – Grace and Rita – attended the novena. With childlike expectant faith, they prayed that Grace would be healed. Riding the streetcar home, Mom noticed that Grace's plaster of Paris cast had cracked from top to bottom. She told the lady who had brought them to the novena. Very worried, Minnie rushed them to U.C. Hospital. The doctor, who had put the new cast on Grace's leg just the week before, carefully removed it. Both of Grace's legs were now exactly the same length. Puzzled, he exclaimed, "It's a miracle!"

With our eyes fixed upon Auntie Grace's crutches still hanging on the wall in St. Anne's shrine, we came to believe that miracles do happen. Not all miracles are as impressive as Jesus feeding the 5,000 with 5 barley loaves and 2 fish; or the healing of our Auntie Grace. May the Holy Spirit open the eyes of our hearts that we may see the many miracles that surround us and give thanks to our God.
