Dear Friends,

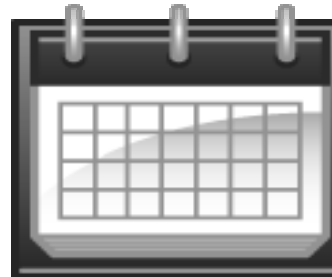
I sit here once again in Gene's big blue chair, sipping Vanilla Chai tea, while contemplating today's readings. Gene and I have always loved this Gospel (Jesus' third appearance following His Resurrection). We see Jesus as He really is – our caring, loving, merciful God. A day or so after Jesus has risen, His closest friends decide to go fishing. Perhaps their food supply is running low and they need to get back to making a living for themselves and for their families. They fish all night long. How disappointed they are to have caught nothing. They see a man on the shore who tells them not to give up, but to try again – cast their nets on the other side of the boat. And so they do! They now catch more fish than their nets are able to hold. All at once, Peter recognizes this stranger on the shore - it is Jesus! Our encounters with Jesus come to us in the ordinary moments of our journey through life. Open our eyes, Lord!

Our ever-impulsive Peter jumps into the sea and makes his way to Jesus. The others follow in their boat. Are they surprised when Jesus takes some of the fish they caught and grills it on the prepared charcoal fire? Do they wonder, "Does Jesus know how to cook? Where did He get the charcoal, the bread?" or had Jesus cooked breakfast for them before? As my Great-grandson Chris tells me, "Gram, Jesus is real!" How more real could Jesus be then to care that His friends are hungry and prepare a hot meal for them? Do we know that God can cook? But then - **"All things are possible with God."**

After they eat, Jesus says to Peter, **"Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?"** Peter answers: **"Yes, Lord, You know that I love You."** Three times, Jesus asks Peter and three times Peter responds: **"Yes, Lord, You know that I love You."** This encounter with Jesus happens so that Peter can repent of his three-time betrayal of Jesus on the night before He was crucified. Jesus' mercy knows no limits. He forgive us of any and all sin, even the seemingly unforgivable sin of denying Him. Jesus calls each of us to come to Him. He forgives us. In thanksgiving for His forgiveness, Jesus says to us: **"Feed My lambs...Tend My sheep...Feed My sheep."** All that Jesus asks of us is to love Him and live His mercy by loving and taking care of one another.
