### **The Power of Loss**

Of all the hurts we experience as human beings, one of the greatest is the loss of a child. Whether we experience a miscarriage, the death of a small child, the accidental death of a teenager, or we outlive our adult children, it is a shattering experience.

In today's gospel, Jesus reaches out to a mother who has lost her only son. He is filled with pity for her and he raises him from the dead.

We know that this great miracle showed who Jesus was. The crowd cries out that "*God has visited his people*".

In our losses, we do not yet experience the resurrection. Our grief is not so easily healed. We often carry the wounds of the loss of our children our whole life. Yet the Lord reminds us that they are safe and that they are not forgotten, nor is our grief forgotten. We will be with them in **God's gift of everlasting life.** As the prayers of the Funeral Mass promise—he will wipe every tear from eyes and there will be no more crying out or pain. *Father Greene*

### **NEW ASSOCIATE PASTOR**

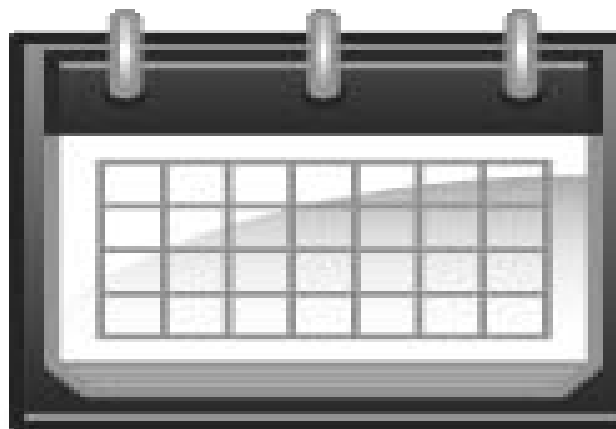
