Witnesses To The Resurrection

At the end of the 19th century, John Henry Cardinal Newman, gave a famous sermon called Witnesses to the Resurrection. His point was that it was not just the apostles and the five hundred other persons who witnessed the Resurrection. Newman told his audience, that all of us as Christians are witnesses of the Resurrection in our lives. By proclaiming our faith in the Risen Christ and living out our faith everyday, we are witnesses to the Risen Lord. We are proclaiming in our lives, the presence of the living Christ both in life and in death. "Whoever believes in me, Jesus says, will have everlasting life."

Mary, who we honor today, was the First Disciple of Jesus. She said to the angel, "let it be done to me even as you say." As the First Disciple, we believe that when she died, she was given the gift of new life in the Resurrection. She rejoined the Son that she gave life and love to.

Mary is a promise to us that we too as disciples will share in Christ's promise of eternal life.

We are currently accepting registration.

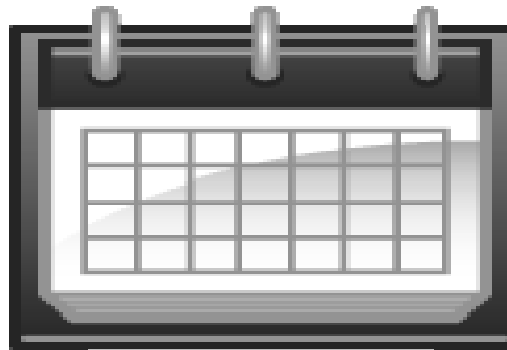
Classes for grades 1-5 begin on Tuesday, September 13 at 3:30pm;

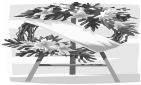

We have received permission from the Archdiocese to paint the exterior our church and rectory. They have not been painted for over twenty years.

Trujillo Company, who recently painted the school has received the contract for this work. The cost of the painting is approximate \$48,000. They will begin painting at the end of August. After the church is painted they will begin painting the rectory. It will take several weeks to complete the painting.

COMPLETING OUR NEW ORGAN

On Monday, August 15, the exterior pipes of our new organ will be packed away. Our parishioner, Pat Uniacke, will be extending the organ grill up to the ceiling of the sanctuary. This will enable the organ to speak more clearly and loudly into the church. This work will take about 2 weeks.

In September, Reuter Organ Company will come to reset the large external organ pipes, fix small problems with the new organ, and add additional pipes.

We still hope to have the formal blessing and inaugural recital in the Fall or after the New Year.
