Dear Parishioners,

In today's first reading from the prophet Isaiah, we hear the inclusiveness of God's salvation: "They shall proclaim my glory among the nations. They shall bring all of your brothers and sisters from all the nations as an offering to the Lord." From Luke's gospel we read: "People will come from the east and the west and from the north and the south and will recline at table in the kingdom of God." Aren't we blest to experience at our Eucharistic table, to have many people from so many different countries and cultures! Do we welcome this foretaste of the heavenly kingdom?

We have another invitation to transform a perspective we may have had since childhood. We've probably been reared to always obey the laws. Along comes Jesus, constantly transgressing the accepted boundaries of his time: disregarding rules about interactions between men and women; touching those thought to be ritually unclean; and healing on the Sabbath, to name a few. When someone's need was in conflict with the law, responding to the person's need always took precedence over keeping the law.

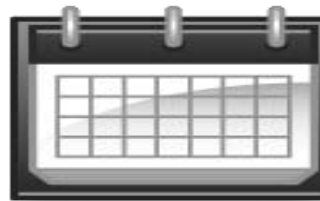

COMPLETING OUR NEW ORGAN

On Monday, August 15, the exterior pipes of our new organ will be packed away. Our parishioner, Pat Uniacke, will be extending the organ grill up to the ceiling of the sanctuary. This will enable the organ to speak more clearly and loudly into the church. This work will take about 2 weeks.

In September, Reuter Organ Company will come to reset the large external organ pipes, fix small problems with the new organ, and add additional pipes.

We still hope to have the formal blessing and inaugural recital in the Fall or after the New Year.

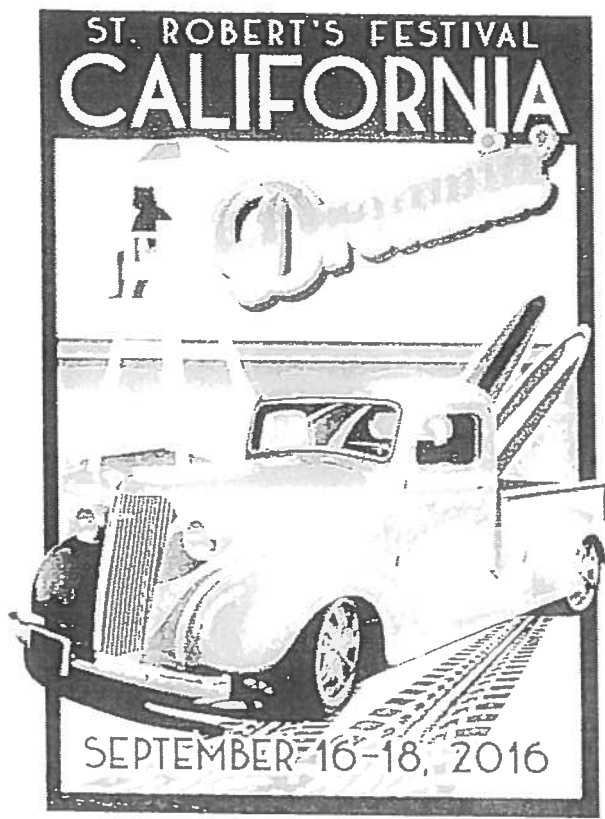

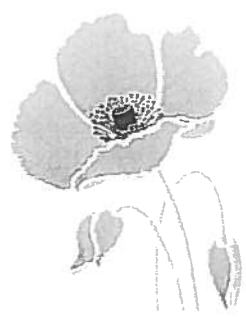

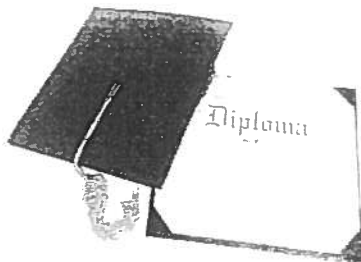
