Food Waste Weekend

The Global Catholic Climate Movement founded in response to Pope Francis' encyclical, "Laudato Si" is calling us this weekend to reflect on our use and waste of food. You may have seen recent articles alerting us to the fact that almost 40% of the food grown and packaged, more than 130 billion pounds is wasted in America with 50 million people (many of them children and seniors) living in poverty. Our parents and grandparents were much more careful with food and many of us grew up with the admonition, "Eat everything on your plate; think of the poor children in China." A fascinating article in foodwasteweekend.org explains the history of why things have changed so drastically. Especially as we hear the story of Lazarus and the rich man who ignores him in his need, it's time to reflect on how our own household values food. Can we remind each other that as part of creation, food is a gift of God to be treasured as well as enjoyed? Can we remember that "best by" means just that and that an item is still good several days after that date? After a party, could we bring carefully stored leftovers to our San Bruno Catholic Worker or share them with a neighbor? Thank you for being good stewards of God's abundance. S.
