A Tribute to Sister Ita Patricia Cleary, PBVM

Sister Ita Patricia Cleary went home to God on Tuesday, October 10, 2017 at Westborough Royale Assisted Living Care Home. Sister Ita Patricia was born in Ballinasloe, Co Galway, Ireland on March 14, 1923 to Patrick Walter Cleary and Amelia O'Brien. She is preceded in death by her parents and siblings, Father Sean Cleary, Gerard Cleary and Sister Annunciata Cleary. She is survived by her sisters Pearl Boland and Vera Gallagher and numerous nieces, nephews, grand nieces, grand nephews and cousins in Ireland, England and United States and the members of her Religious Congregation, Union of Sisters of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Sister Ita Patricia entered the Presentation Sisters in Thurles, Co Tipperary, Ireland in 1942. She attended Carysfort Teaching College, Dublin, Ireland and Lone Mountain College, San Francisco, CA. She taught grade school in Thurles, Co Tipperary, and served as Principal at Presentation School, Hospital, Co. Limerick, Ireland. In 1970 Sister Ita was missioned to teach at St. Roberts Catholic School, San Bruno, CA. In the ensuing years she served as Parish Director of Religious Education and Pastoral Associate to the Sick and Homebound, St. Vincent De Paul Society and Legion of Mary. She also served as Director of Presentation Associates in San Bruno, CA.

Sister Ita will be fondly remembered for her infectious smile and friendly and welcoming personality. She will also be remembered for her musical and storytelling talents, her creative ability with knitting and crochet needles, her Bible Study Classes that she taught at St. Robert Parish and Mercy Center, Burlingame, CA and her participation as a student in the Spanish Classes at San Bruno Senior Center. Sister Ita was a cancer survivor for over forty years.

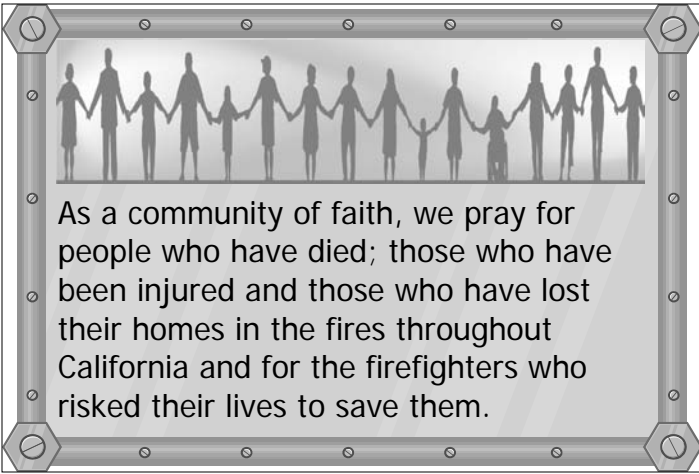
Health Fair Oct. 22
