Dear Friends,

Sitting here in our living room, sipping Huckleberry tea and gazing at the blue waters of San Francisco Bay, I remember another Pentecost 42 years ago. Joyfully thanking God for bringing Gene and me together and for the life we share, I prayed: "Jesus, I know You. Father, I know You. But Holy Spirit, I really don't know You. Please help me to know you." Within the hour, my dear friend Nancy St. John called to tell me that a priest was coming to St. Luke's in Foster City on the following Saturday to give a seminar on the Holy Spirit.

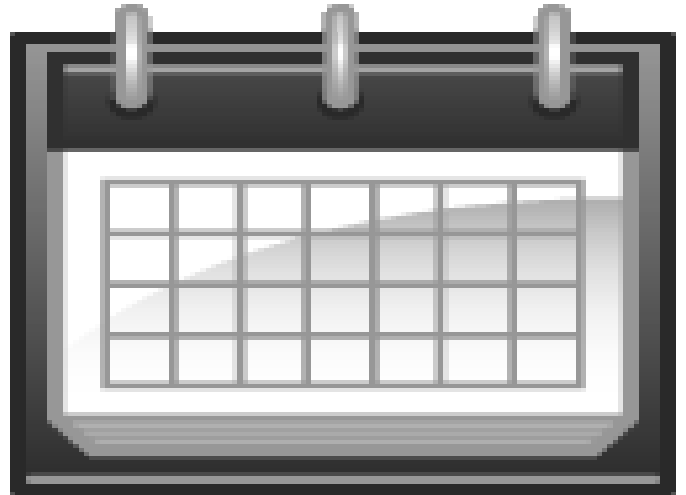
Gene and I went. It was there that the Holy Spirit began to reveal Himself to us. We learned that He (the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity) is the Love between the Father and the Son – The Living Water poured into our heart when we are baptized. From then on, we are never alone; our God lives within us. Jesus has given us His Holy Spirit as our Advocate with the Father; our Comforter in times of sorrow and pain; the guiding force in all that we think, say or do (if we but listen to Him). He teaches us how to pray and how to have an intimate relationship with our God. He prompts us to love others; reach out to them; and help them in their time of need. The Holy Spirit gives us strength and courage when we feel we cannot go on. He says to us: **"Be still and know that I am here."** He heals us; encourages us; renews our hope; increases our faith and deepens our love.

Let us open our hearts and minds to the Holy Spirit; invite Him into our life; listen to Him as He speaks to us; be guided and nourished by Him each and every day of our life.

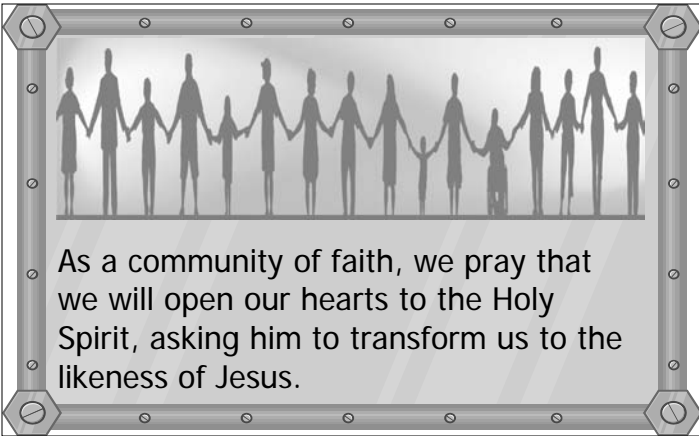

ALL ARE SENT

Fifty days after Easter Sunday we celebrate the fulfillment of all God's promises in the feast of Pentecost, a feast that has sometimes been called the birthday of the church. One last time we are reminded that we Christians have received the Holy Spirit, not for our own benefit, but to enable us to follow our Christian vocation.

The centerpiece of the scriptures for Pentecost is the account in Acts of the Apostles of the sending of the Holy Spirit to the disciples. The other readings for this Sunday help us to understand what it means to live out our Christian vocation. Paul's letter shows us the gifts and fruits that the Holy Spirit gives to us. John's Gospel reminds us that Jesus has sent all his disciples to share his forgiveness and peace, through the power of the Holy Spirit.
