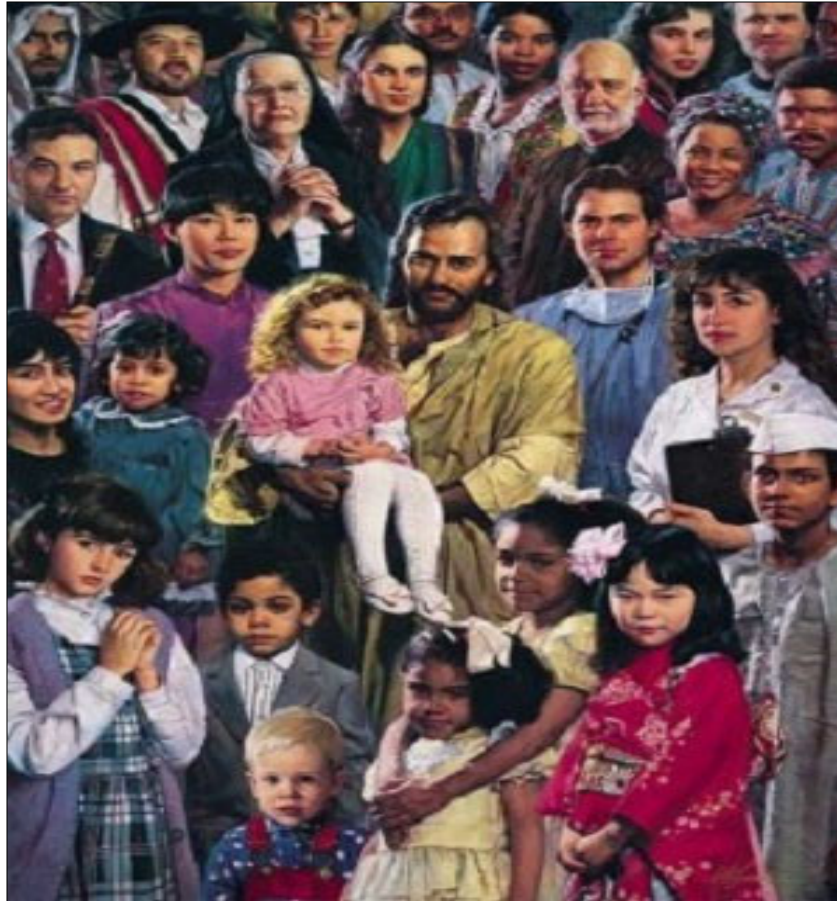

We can promise ourselves to believe—really believe—that while we are not sinless, we are forgiven. 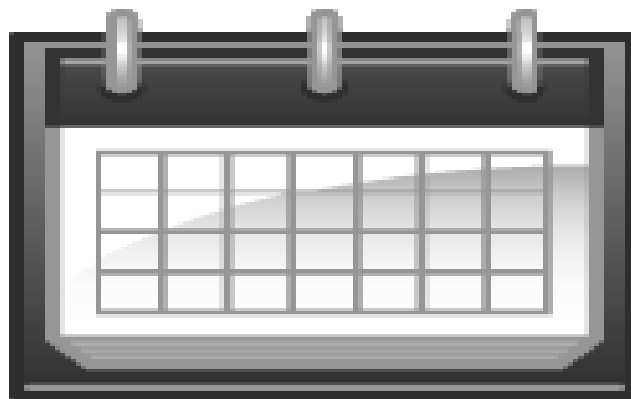

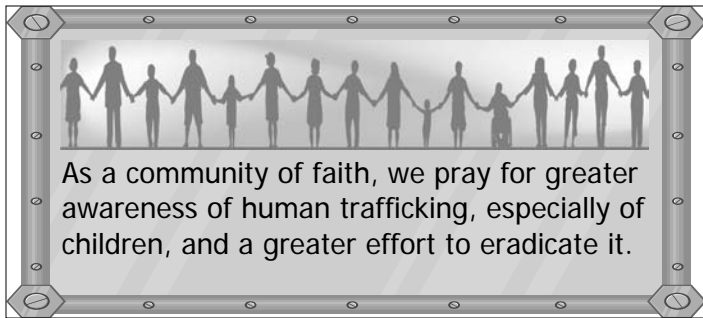
