Dear Friends,

It is a beautiful Summer day here in San Bruno. I sit on our deck with the sweet fragrance of jasmine tickling my nose. Life is good! God is good! As I sip my Earl Grey tea, I think about a dear friend, whom I have know for many years. I feel so sad for her because she lives in fear; never even realizing that she is a very frightened woman; always expecting the worst to happen. She doesn't see the beauty that surrounds her or the many ways in which God has blessed her. Her mother didn't have a single positive thought in her head. She worried constantly and was "a prophet of doom". Could it be that being raised by such a mother made my friend the way she is? I pray that Jesus would fill her with peace and hope; that soon she will focus on all that is good and live a life of gratitude and peace. Now I begin to study today's readings.

It really is true that there is no such thing as coincidence and God does speak to us through His Word. Jeremiah relates: ***"I will appoint shepherds for them who will shepherd them so that they need no longer fear and tremble."*** Next comes my favorite Psalm 23: ***"Even though I walk in the dark valley I fear no evil; for you are at my side with your rod and your staff that gives me courage...Only goodness and kindness follow me all the days of my life; and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord for years to come."***

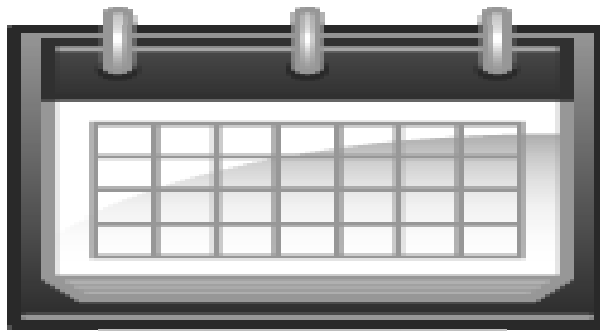
Then St. Paul tells us of Jesus: ***"He came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near, for through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father."*** Finally, Mark tells us: ***"When he disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd, and he began to teach them many things."***

Throughout Scripture, we read again and again: ***"Do not be afraid; I am with you."*** Jesus is the loving, caring, merciful Good Shepherd whom Our Father has sent to us to drive away our fear. When worry and doubt try to overcome us, all we need do is say:

"JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU!"
