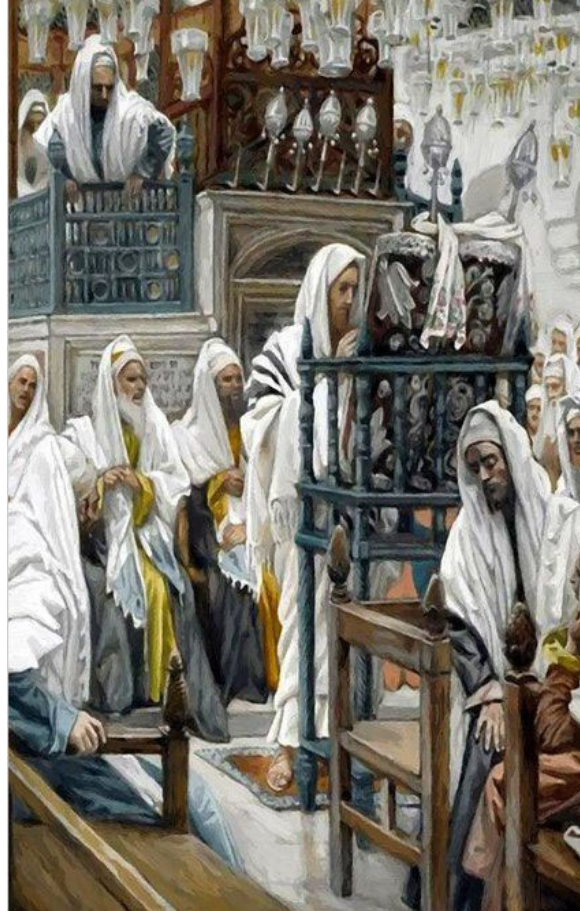

LISTENING

One of the hardest things to do is to really listen to someone when they are speaking to us. We are often not really listening or we are just pretending to listen. Our real thoughts and reactions are often somewhere else.

It really takes effort to hear what someone is saying to us and respond in a way that indicates that we really heard what the person was sharing with us.

In today's Gospel, Jesus calls attention to himself in the synagogue when he starts preaching. At first, some are amazed at the power of his words but shortly they are angered by his teaching and even want to kill him. They miss the point that Jesus is making, that the Spirit of the Lord is upon him and that God has sent him not just to the Jews but for the Gentiles as well. They miss the point he was making.

How about us? Sometimes we don't hear what God is saying to us and sometimes we don't hear what we are sharing with each other. Listening demands concentration and it demands openness of the heart and hearing.

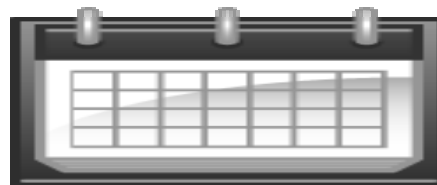

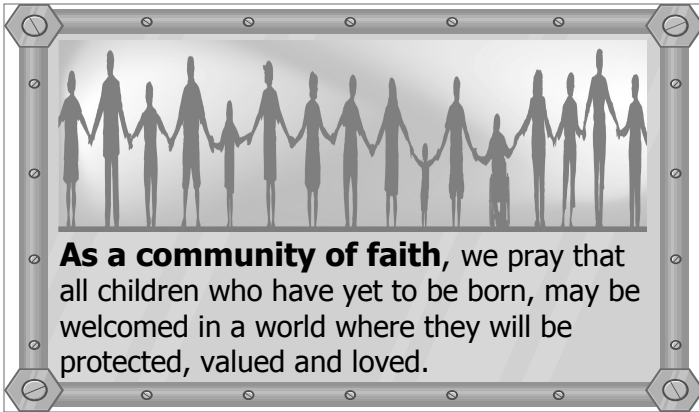
