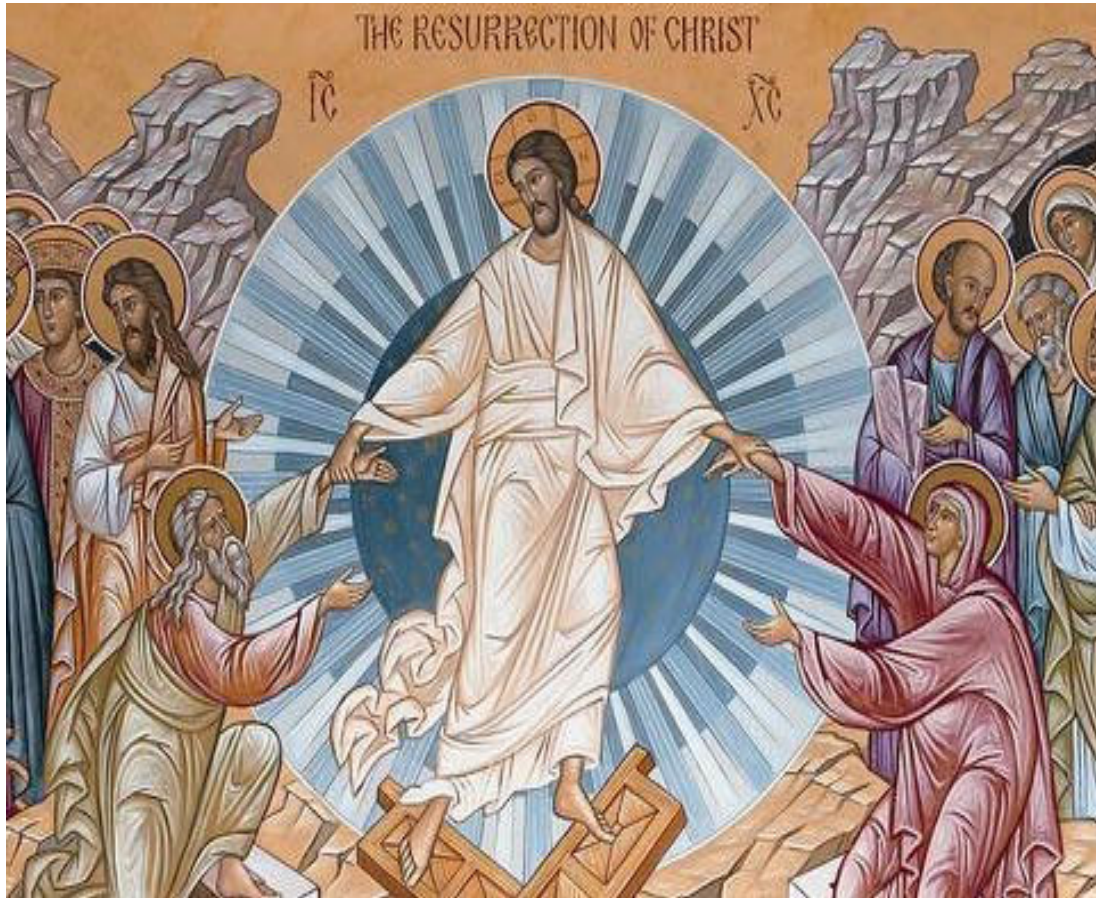

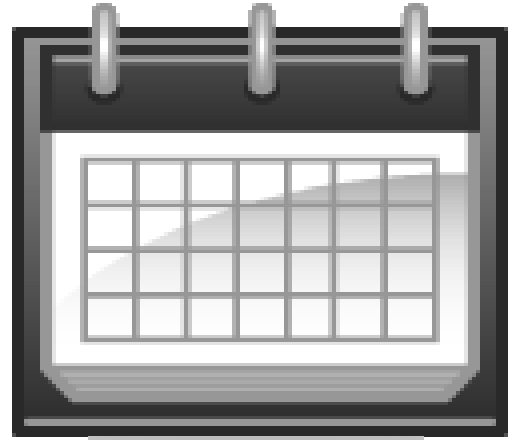
### Easter Duty

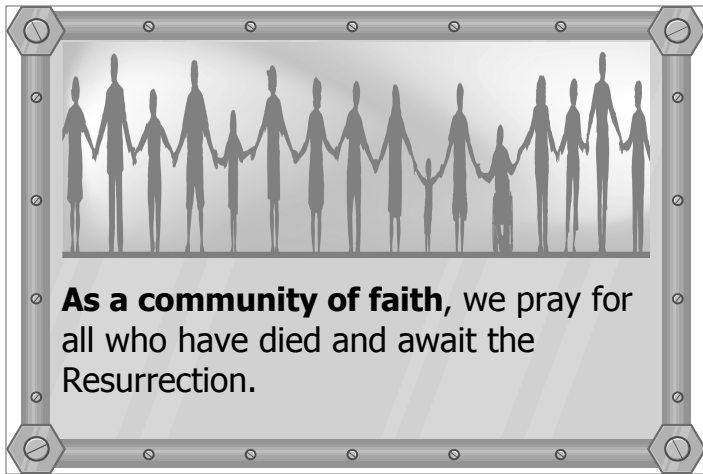
