Vacations

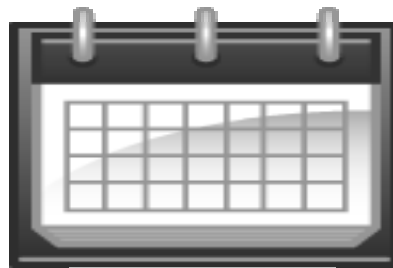
Fr. Boie will be away on his vacation from May 14th to June 14th.

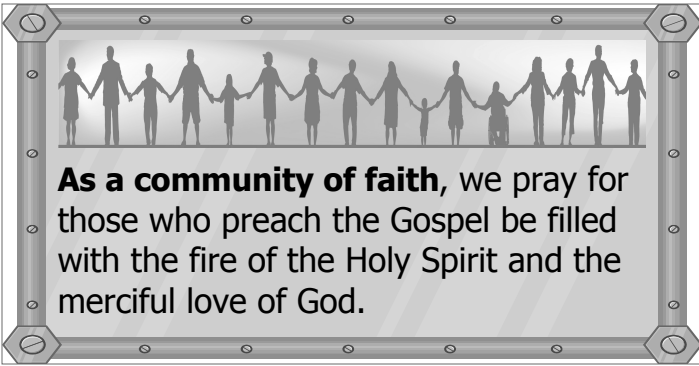
