Their forgiveness has taken great courage and is given at great risks.

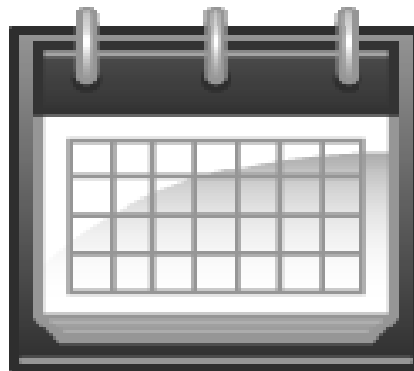

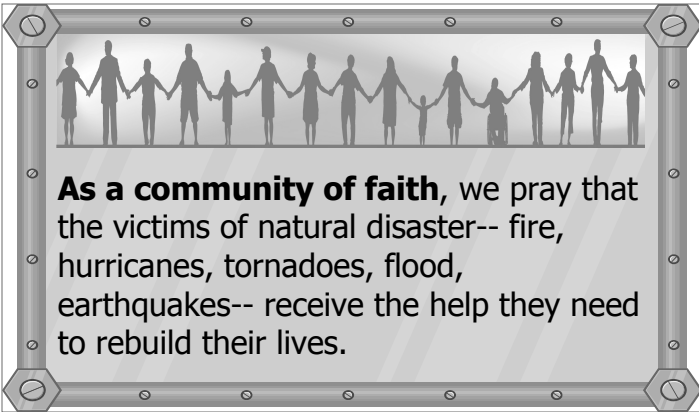
