A PRAYER to bless your work, a cheer to lighten your moments .... and a wish that GOD will always grant you a blessed day!"

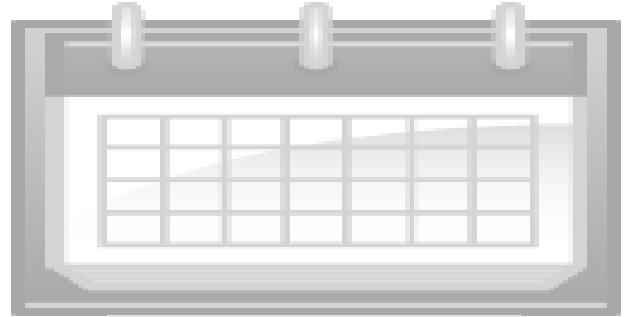
