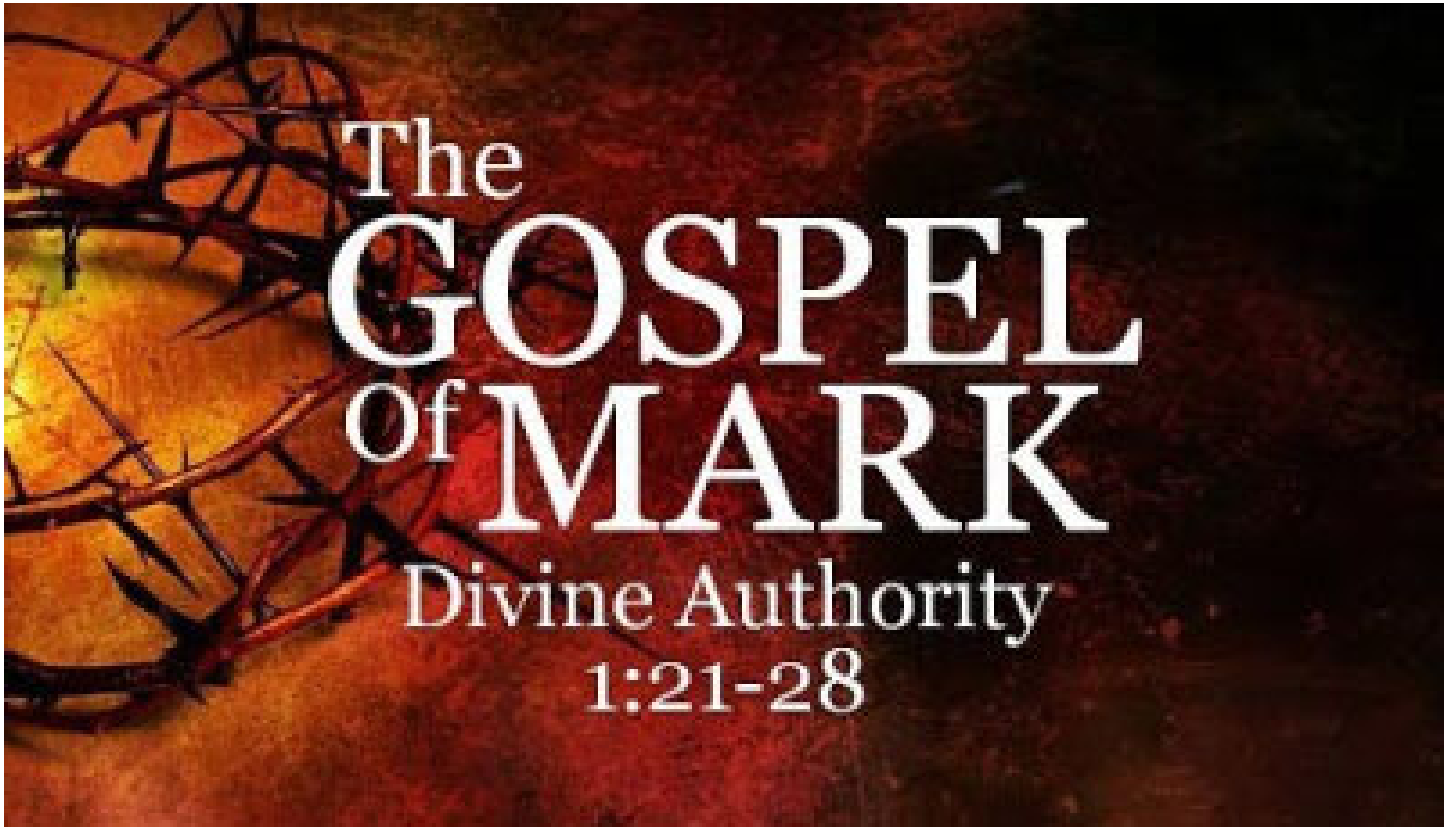

Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness for they will be satisfied.

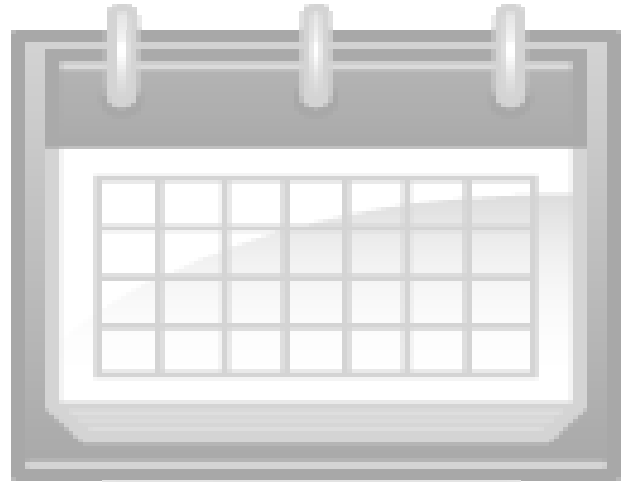
Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

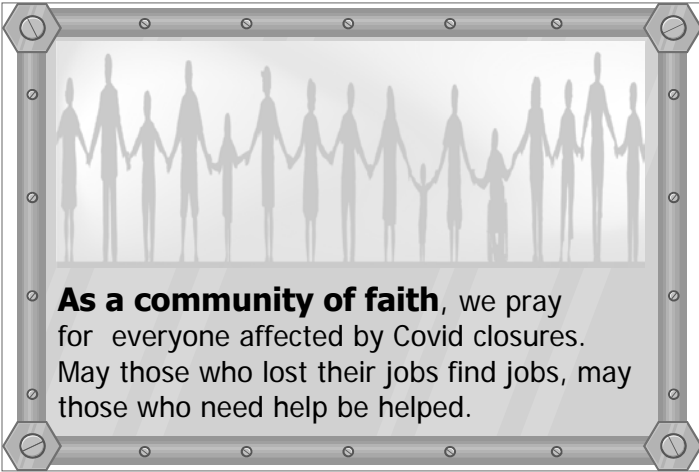

Heating System

Steve Bowers, the Director of Building and Construction for the Archdiocese of San Francisco, came by last Tuesday with a mechanical engineer to evaluate our church heating system and provide us with a better option or solution. Another mechanical engineer is coming next week to do the same and for a second opinion. I hope after this visit which is so vital in our decision, we can now proceed with the work. We feel we have already wasted a lot of time and many months of just looking into it. But there is always wisdom in waiting and even power in pausing.

Archdiocesan Annual Appeal Extended

The 2020 Archdiocesan Annual Appeal has been extended until the end of the month of January. Our parish still needs roughly around 30 thousand dollars to complete our goal. Considering the hard times, the Archdiocese has created a Task Force to evaluate the 2020 AAA parish goals and results in the next few weeks, making adjustments or deferrals if/where appropriate. We can only do our best to be generous in these times. The 2021 AAA will be delayed than the usual start and will formally begin on Monday, February 22nd.
