I can't help but picture it and wonder what would it be like if Jesus was here amongst us right now, in 2021.

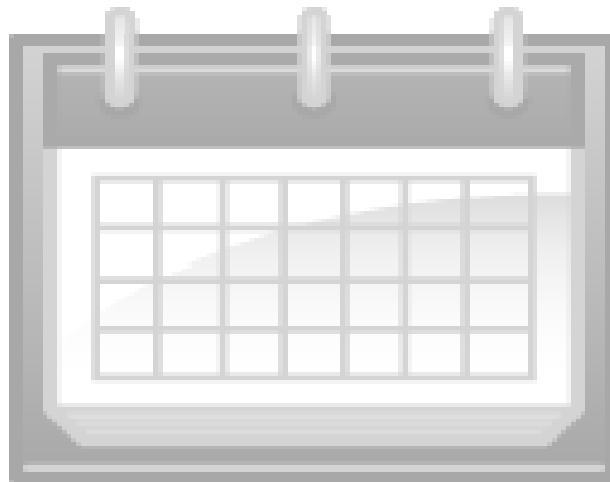
Would we humble ourselves? Would our faith shine through.

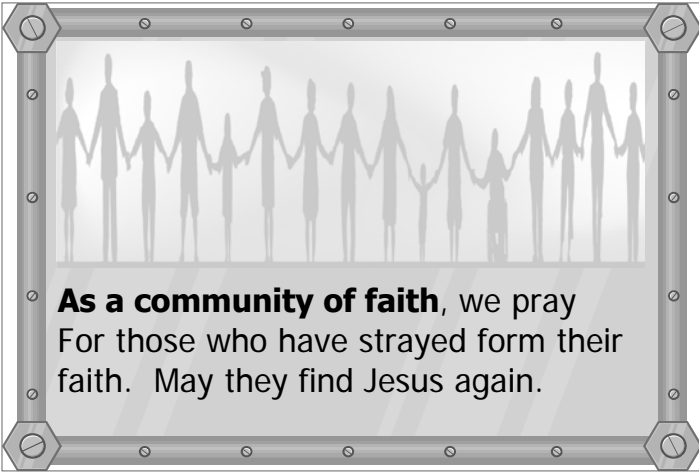
