DO YOU WANT TO FAST THIS LENT?

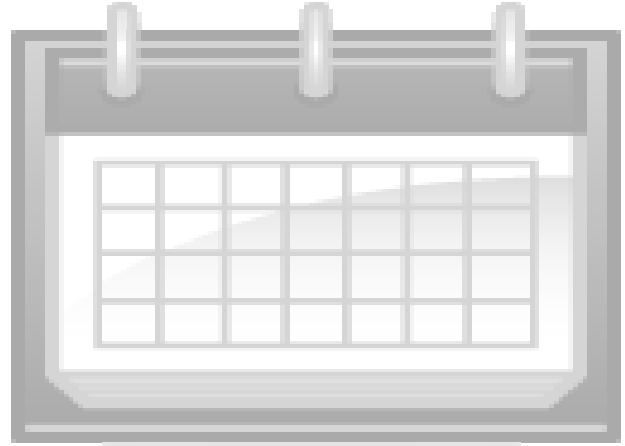
In the words of Pope Francis

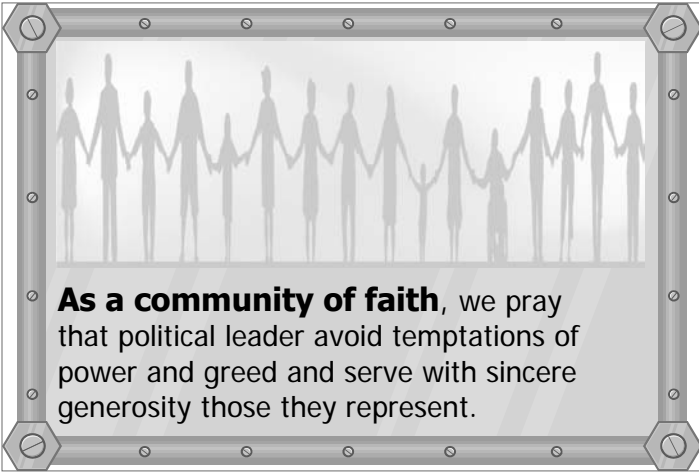
