Feeling stressed? What if we could help people with mental health issues using text messaging? That's why I want to tell you about a free and 100% confidential service called Sr. Hope.

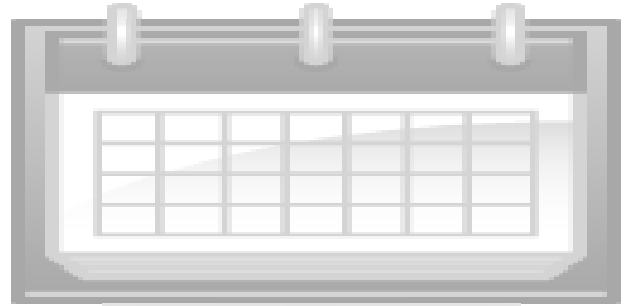

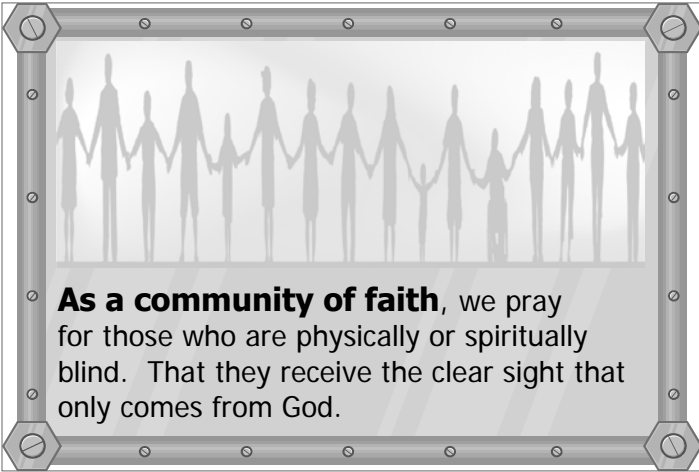
