Take note we also have 7:30AM and 5:00PM masses this Sunday. All masses are indoor and livestreamed as well.

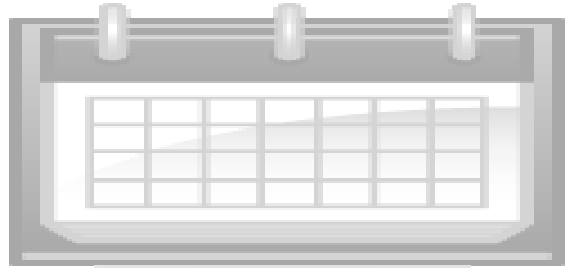
Not quite yet!

Early this week, The State of California judicial rulings **lifted all capacity limits** on worship services, but continues to strongly recommend that houses of worship follow guidelines of the tier of the county in which they are located. The Archbishop sent a text message to all the priests telling us to continue to adhere to the safety protocols of the Archdiocese with one modification: base the number of people inside according to the 6 foot rule, rather an absolute number of percentage capacity. That is, each household should be 6 feet apart.
