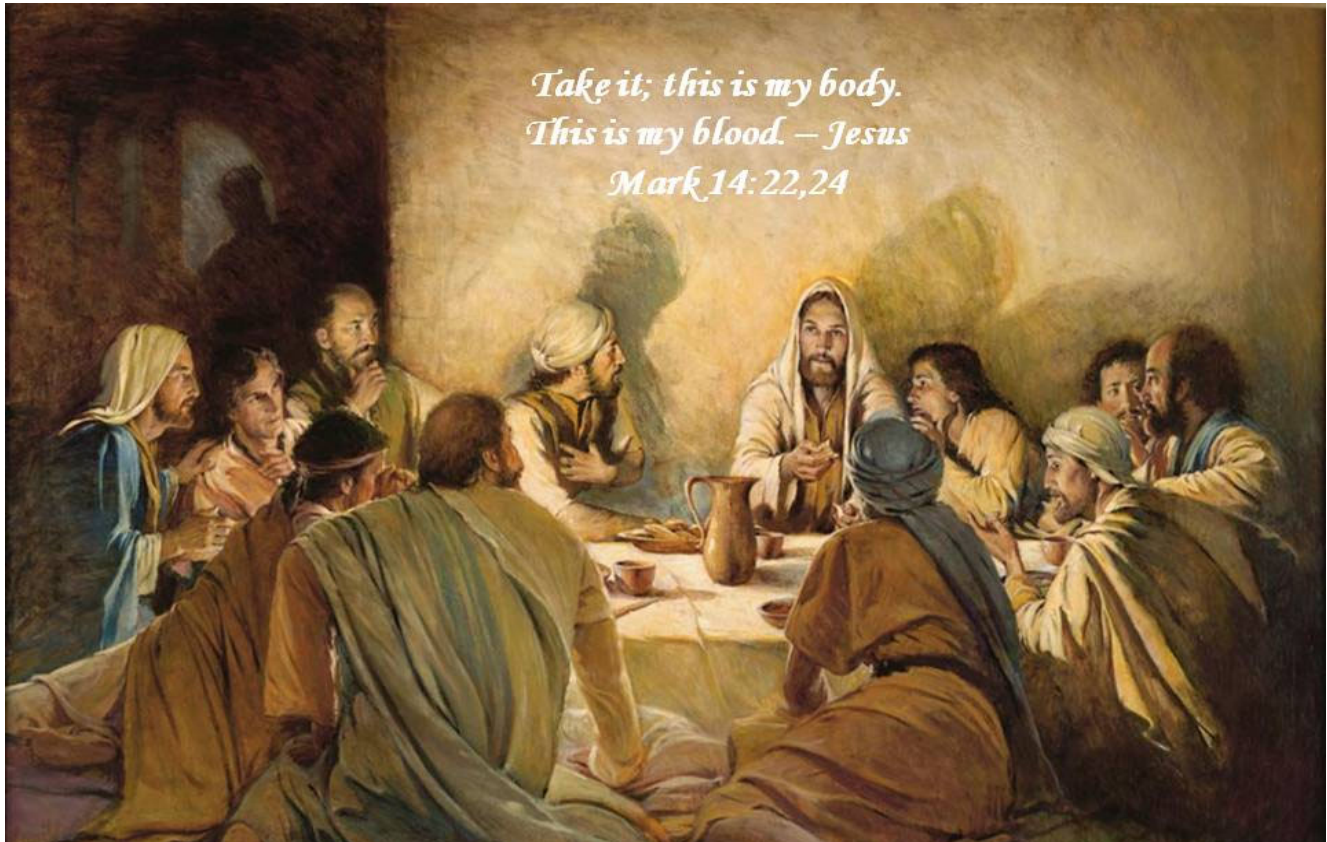

they comfort me.

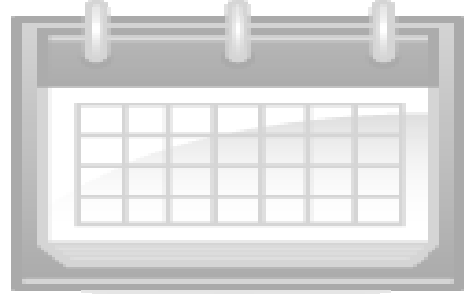
Thou preparest a table before

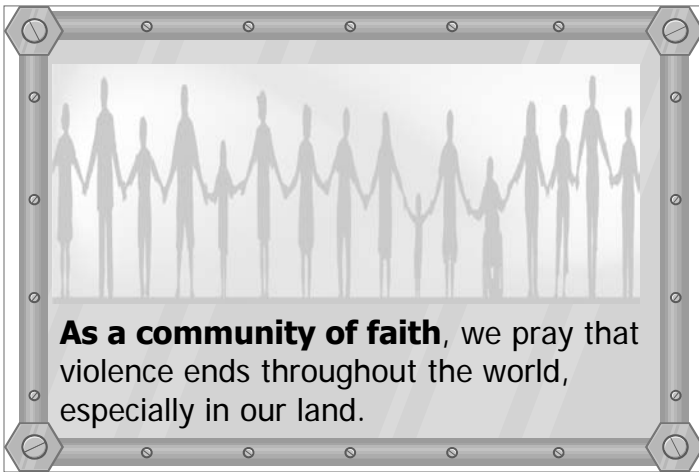
