News and updates on the reopening for public masses

- The dispensation for attending Sunday mass has been dropped and Sunday mass obligation is restored. However, anyone who feels sick is dispensed from attending mass by canon law itself.

- Here are some modifications taken from the safety protocols in effect for the Archdiocese of San Francisco

* Social distancing is reduced to 3 feet between households;

*People are to wear masks for indoor masses at all times (except if they have a physical or personal difficulty with it or have a specific role to carry out in the liturgy)

* Sign of Peace to be exchanged by the people reverently by bowing to those near them.

* Everyone is encouraged to maintain hygienic protocols such social distancing, and washing or sanitizing of hands.

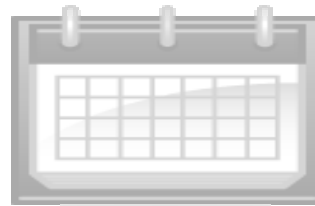
*At St. Robert's, we have started restoring communion procession, that is, people receive communion by lining up in procession to the ministers and not anymore in their pews.

*We will also restore putting of holy water in stoups at entrances of the church.

*We will continue to livestream our masses **except** Sunday, 7:30am and 5:00 pm masses.

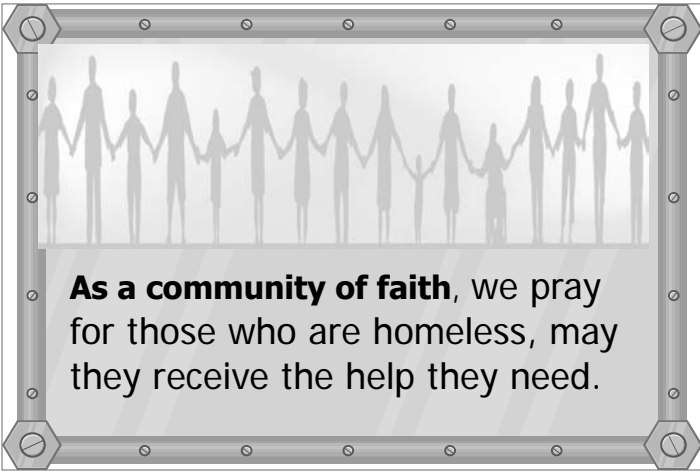
