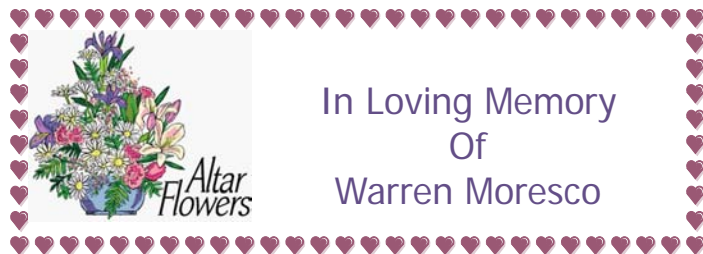
Archdiocesan Annual Appeal
