For the past several years, our parish has facilitated the monthly grocery distribution program for The Second Harvest Food Bank, at Belle Air Elementary School, 450 Third Ave. Each distribution provides about 20,000 lbs. of food to over 200 families in need. The distribution is accomplished 100% by volunteers from parishioners of our parish and community members, overseen by Sister Sheryl. The program had always been scheduled on the 4th Thursday of each month, however, beginning on 9/22/21, the day has changed to the 4th WEDNESDAY of the month (except for holiday months). If you would like to volunteer to help those less fortunate, just show up at Belle Air school about 1:45 (until 4:15) on the 4th Wednesday (over 18 years old or 16-17 with parents written permission).
