ROSES HAVE THORNS for us to realize that we need to be careful or else we will get Wounded.

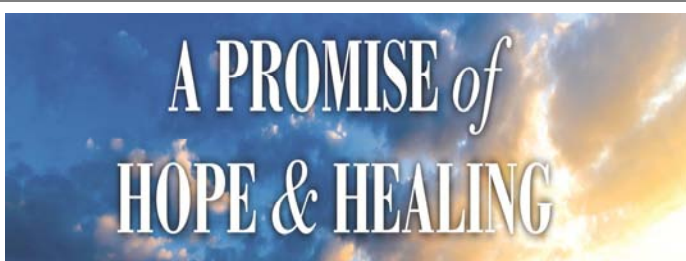
Lastly, BOOKS HAVE COVERS for us to realize that what we think is not always right.
