SVdP THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE

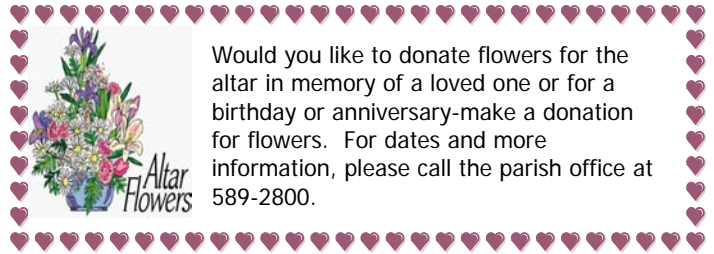
