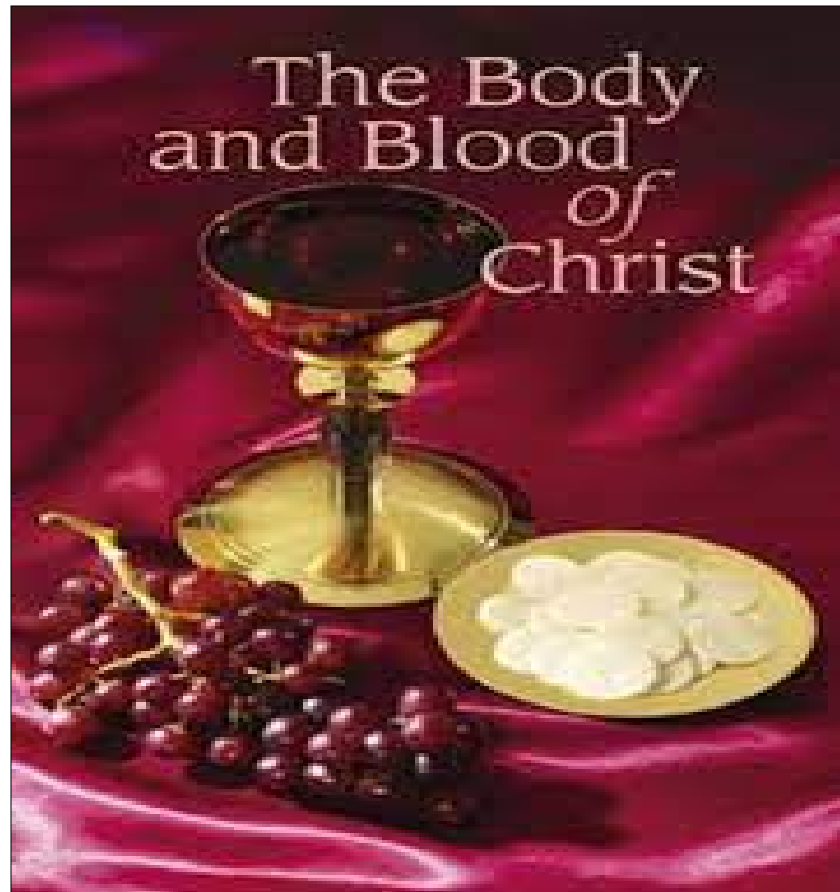

And may we be SUNSHINE to one another.

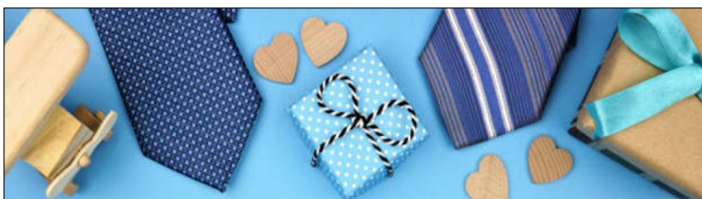
