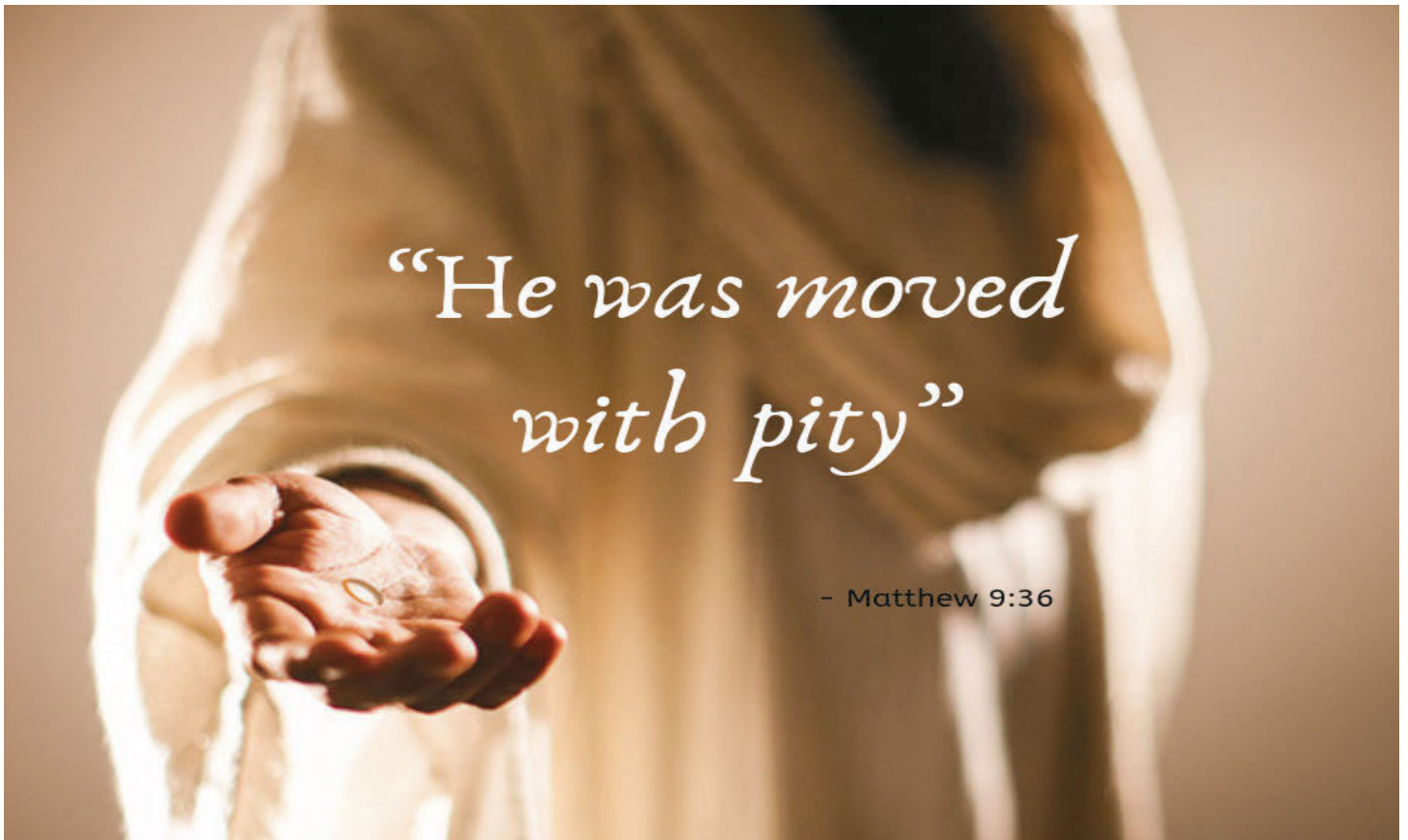

JOB DESCRIPTION

- Greets and refers visitors to the appropriate ministers, services or agencies.
- Answers the phone and provides appropriate information or refers calls.
- Responsible for preparing bulk mailings, obtaining volunteers and delivery to the post office. (3x a year)
- Responsible for Annual Appeal mailing and record keeping.
- Prepares and writes checks (parish/school/funds) on a weekly basis.
- Inputs deposit entries into the computer (parish/school/funds) bi-weekly.
- Responsible for sections of the weekly bulletin.
- Updates and maintains parish filing system.
- Sets up Mass Intention Calendar for the coming year.
- Schedules the daily Mass Intentions.
- Updates baptism and wedding schedules on a weekly basis.
- Prepares baptismal certificates.
- Records Baptisms and Weddings in books in a safe.
- Maintains and orders office supplies, Mass Intention books & Daily Mass Records.
- Performs secretarial work for designated staff.
- Covers for the secretary when on vacation.
- Records Vanco donations (monthly) into Quick Books.
- Works with the Accountant regarding monthly print-outs of bank statements.
- Notify the Web Master of website changes/additions/deletions (i.e., Weekly Sunday Deposits, Christmas and Easter schedules, phone numbers, etc).
