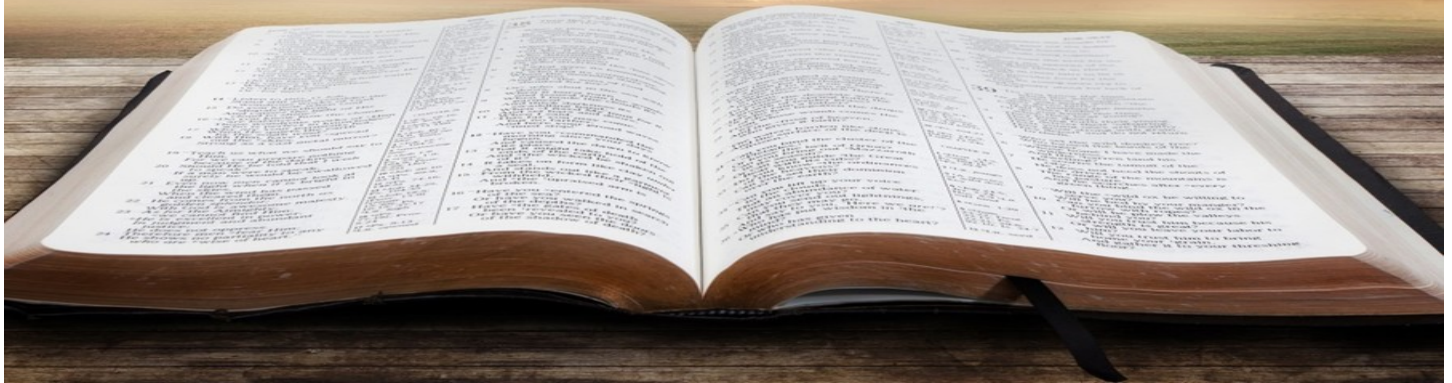

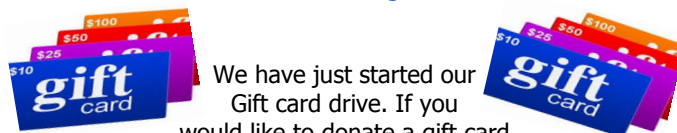


Dear Saint Robert Parish Community,
