Kindergarten

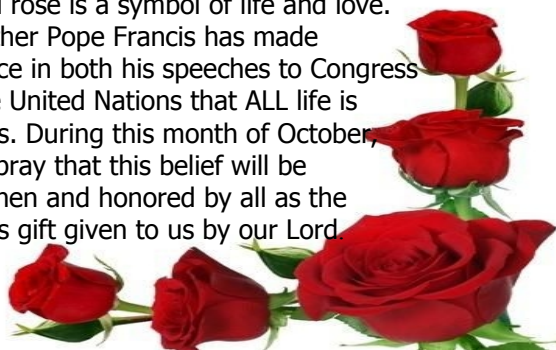

REMEMBRANCE MASS

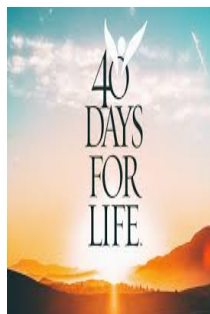
A special Memorial Mass will be offered on **Saturday, November 2nd, at 7 PM.**
