## REMEMBRANCE MASS

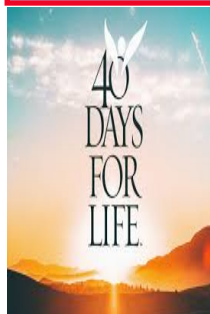
