# G.P.'s Music Corner

Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul

The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul calls each of us not only to honor two great pillars of the Church, but to recognize the same call to holiness in our own lives. Peter, flawed yet faithful, and Paul, once a persecutor turned fearless evangelist, show us that sanctity is not about perfection but about saying "yes" to God—even when the path is uncertain or filled with hardship. Their lives remind us that every Christian is called to be a saint: to proclaim the Gospel, to endure trials with hope, and to trust in Christ who goes before us.

The song *Be Not Afraid* becomes a gentle yet powerful invitation to walk that same path. Its verses reflect the challenges of discipleship—wandering in uncertainty, facing danger, enduring rejection—but also echo Jesus' constant reassurance: "I am with you through it all." As we reflect on Peter and Paul, the song reminds us that courage and holiness are not reserved for the apostles of old. They are lived out today, in our own choices to follow Christ, to speak truth, and to love boldly—right where we are.
