G.P.'s Music Corner

14th Sunday in OT

In today's world, many of us carry a quiet, persistent guilt—a sense of unease that while we laugh with friends, sip coffee in the morning sun, or gather for holidays like the Fourth of July, others are grieving, fleeing, or suffering. There's a heaviness in knowing that while we enjoy relative freedom and peace, wars rage, injustice thrives, and lives are lost elsewhere. The lyrics of Jesse Manibusan's Hold On to Love speak to this tension: "There is a place for the sadness... there is a season of gladness." These lines remind us that joy and sorrow coexist, and rather than feel guilty for the goodness in our lives, we're invited to hold on to love—to let love anchor us, stretch us, and compel us to be present to both the beauty and the brokenness of the world.

Bringing Christ into our daily lives—into our laughter, our meals, our celebrations—redeems those moments. It allows us to live with awareness and compassion, rather than avoidance or shame. The song's refrain is a gentle commandment: "Hold on to Love, where grace and mercy's overflowing." As we mark Independence Day, we're reminded that true freedom is not only political—it is spiritual, and rooted in love. In Christ, our gladness becomes more than fleeting pleasure; it becomes a wellspring of hope and a means of healing. When we root our joy in God, it does not ignore the world's pain—it becomes a response to it. Our acts of gratitude, kindness, and communion become small but powerful ways of holding on to love in a world that needs it.
