

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

*O Sacrum Convivium means "O Sacred Banquet," and it's a prayer that celebrates the gift of the Eucharist—where Catholics believe Jesus is truly present in the bread and wine. It's often sung or prayed during the feast of **Corpus Christi**, which honors this sacred meal. The prayer reminds us that the Eucharist helps us remember Jesus' sacrifice, fills us with grace, and gives us hope for heaven.*

Ricky Manalo's version of this hymn keeps the heart of the old Latin prayer but adds new words that help us understand how the Eucharist should shape our lives today. His lyrics talk about becoming more like Jesus, helping the poor, caring for the sick, and loving others. The music is simple and beautiful, so people of all ages can sing it and feel close to God. It helps us see that receiving Jesus in the Eucharist isn't just about what happens at Mass—it's about how we live every day.
